TDA Master Plan

Mr. Eric Woolridge, President and Director of Planning for Destination by Design, presented a 15year Master Plan to better market the local community as a destination for tourist. Proposed capitol projects for downtown Marion, Old Fort and Little Switzerland was presented, as well as ways to brand McDowell to tourist. The new logo presented for McDowell County was "Blue Ridge Mountain Wonderland." The Town of Old Fort suggested logo was "Pisgah First."

One of the recommendations was for improving the flow of traffic in and around the McDowell House at the Joseph McDowell Historical Catawba Greenway.

After discussion the consensus of the group was to have two members from the Board of Commissioners, City Council, Town Aldermen, Chamber of Commerce, and TDA to form a steering committee to identify a project and funding sources.
