This form is to be remitted and taxes paid by the 20th of each month following the month in which the tax accrues to avoid penalties. Payments and forms can be mailed, or delivered in person to the McDowell County Finance Department at 60 East Court Street, Marion NC 28752, or mailed to the McDowell County Finance at same address. The McDowell County Occupancy Tax is currently 6% of the gross receipts derived from the rental of any room, lodging, or similar place within the County subject to sales tax under North Carolina General Assembly Session Law 2007-315, Senate Bill 16.

Applicable penalties are defined as:

1) Failure to pay tax when due, without intent to evade the tax, will result in a penalty of ten dollars (\$10.00) for each day's omission.

Remittance should be made by check or money order payable to McDowell County Finance.

2) Failure to file the return on the date it is due will result in a penalty equal to five percent (5%) of the amount of the tax if the failure is for one month, with an additional five percent (5%) for each additional month thereof, during which the failure continues.

This report must be returned even if no amount is due.
